At the recent parents evening I spoke with you briefly about reading. This letter just gives you a recap of what was discussed.

In class the children are very busy learning 'speed sounds' and then beginning to blend these sounds together to form short words. In your child's book bag there is a speed sounds card with the sounds on your child has already learnt, these will be added to as we do more. Please practise these sounds with your child so they can recall them at speed.

In school we use the Primary National Strategy 'Letters and Sounds' documentation and the 'Read Write Inc' literacy programme by Ruth Miskin. If you would like some more information about either of these please ask, or alternatively there is lots of information on both of these on the internet.

To begin with your child will bring home a library book to share and will then progress on to the school reading scheme when we feel they are ready.
