## Trinity St Peter's CE Primary School Admissions Criteria 2018-2019

- 1) Looked after or previously looked after children.
- 2) Children who have a sibling\* currently attending the school and who will still be there at the start of the new academic year
- 3) Children **and** parents/grandparents who worship regularly\*\* at either St Peter's or Holy Trinity Churches. (This includes the Church in the school at Redgate). **The application must be supported by a letter from the Vicar**  
\*\*\*
- 4) Children **and** parents/grandparents who worship regularly\*\* at another Christian Church\*\*\*\*. **The application must be supported by a letter from the Vicar/Minister/Parish Priest**\*\*\*
- 5) Children who live closest to the main entrance of the school as measured via the safest walking route.

*In the event of **any over-subscription** in the number of applications made under criteria 2, 3 and 4 above then the admissions committee will offer places in accord with the criterion that follows e.g. If Criterion 2 is oversubscribed then places will be offered to those also fulfilling criterion 3, then 4 and ultimately to those living closest to the school measured by the shortest walking distance from the child's home to the nearest school gate. We will measure from the property's address point, to the nearest school gate (using recognised routes known to the Authority at the time of measurement)*

## NOTES

\* **Siblings.** This includes half-brothers and sisters, step-brothers and sisters living in the same house

\*\* **Regular attendance** is deemed to be **AT LEAST MONTHLY** for the past 12 months. (prior to the published date for the closure of the application process, which is normally around the middle of January) *Family attendance at church services which can include attendance at Messy Church Formby and WOW will be considered as part of this requirement.*  
Parents/grandparents include step parents/grandparents and carers.

\*\*\* **Letter of Support** . - Only letters of support that **CLEARLY SHOW** that the conditions in respect of 'regular attendance' have been met will be considered.

\*\*\*\* ***Another Trinitarian Christian Church.***

+ **Looked after children – children in public care** -This includes any "looked after child" and any child who was previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption or a residence of special guardianship order

+ **Twins, multiple births** -Where there are twins, triplets wanting admission and there is only a single place left within the admission number, then the governing body will exercise as much flexibility as possible within the requirements of infant class sizes. In exceptional circumstances we are now able to offer places for both twins and all triplets, even when this means breaching infant class size limits

**NURSERY:** Please note that attendance at the school Nursery **forms no part of the above admissions process** The Nursery has its own criteria as it is not legally regarded as part of the formal education process which starts with admission into reception. Admission to the School Reception class is open to all children irrespective of whether or not they have attended the school nursery.
