

Year 4 End of Year Spanish Expectations

Working at the Expected Standard (EXP):

Pupil(s) are confidently and independently able to:

Listening:

- Show understanding of a range of familiar spoken phrases.
- Listen to and accurately repeat particular sounds in songs and rhymes.
- Notice that similar Spanish sounds may be spelt differently to English.
- Ask and answer a range of questions on difficult topic areas.

Speaking:

- Ask and answer a range of questions on different topic areas.
- Use familiar sentences as models to create new sentences.
- Read aloud using accurate pronunciation.

Reading:

- Read a range of familiar written phrases and sentences, recognising their meaning and reading them aloud accurately.
- Follow the written version of a text he/she is listening to.
- Begin to work out the meaning of unfamiliar words within a familiar text using clues.

Writing

- Write words and short phrases from memory.
- Use a range of adjectives to describe things in more detail, such as describing someone's appearance.
- Write descriptive sentences using a model, but supplying some words from memory.

Grammar

- Recognise a wider range of word classes including pronouns and use them appropriately.
- Understand that adjectives may change form according to the noun they relate to.
- Recognise questions and negative sentences.
