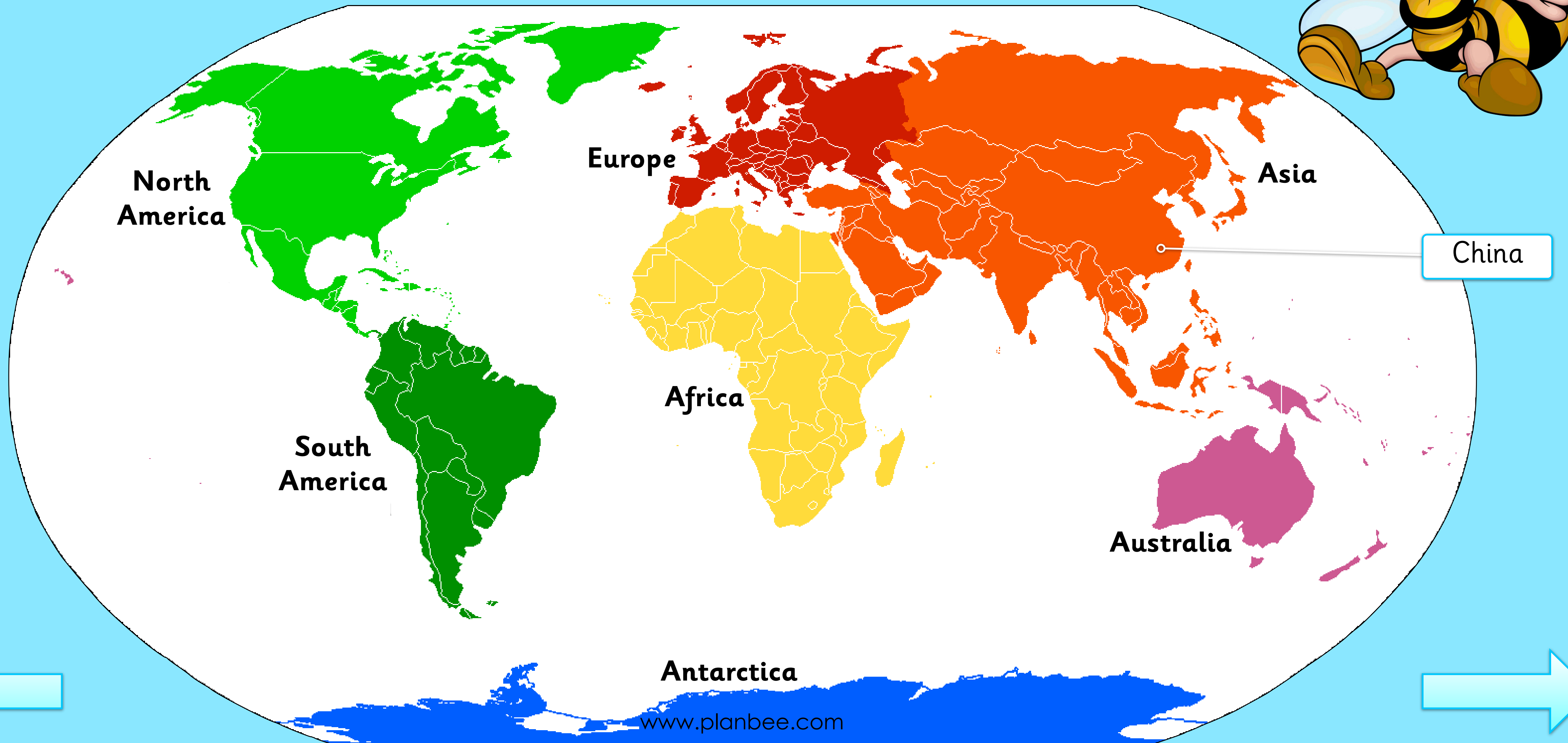


Today I am going to visit CHINA. China is a country in ASIA.

Did you know that there are 1.3 billion people living in China?



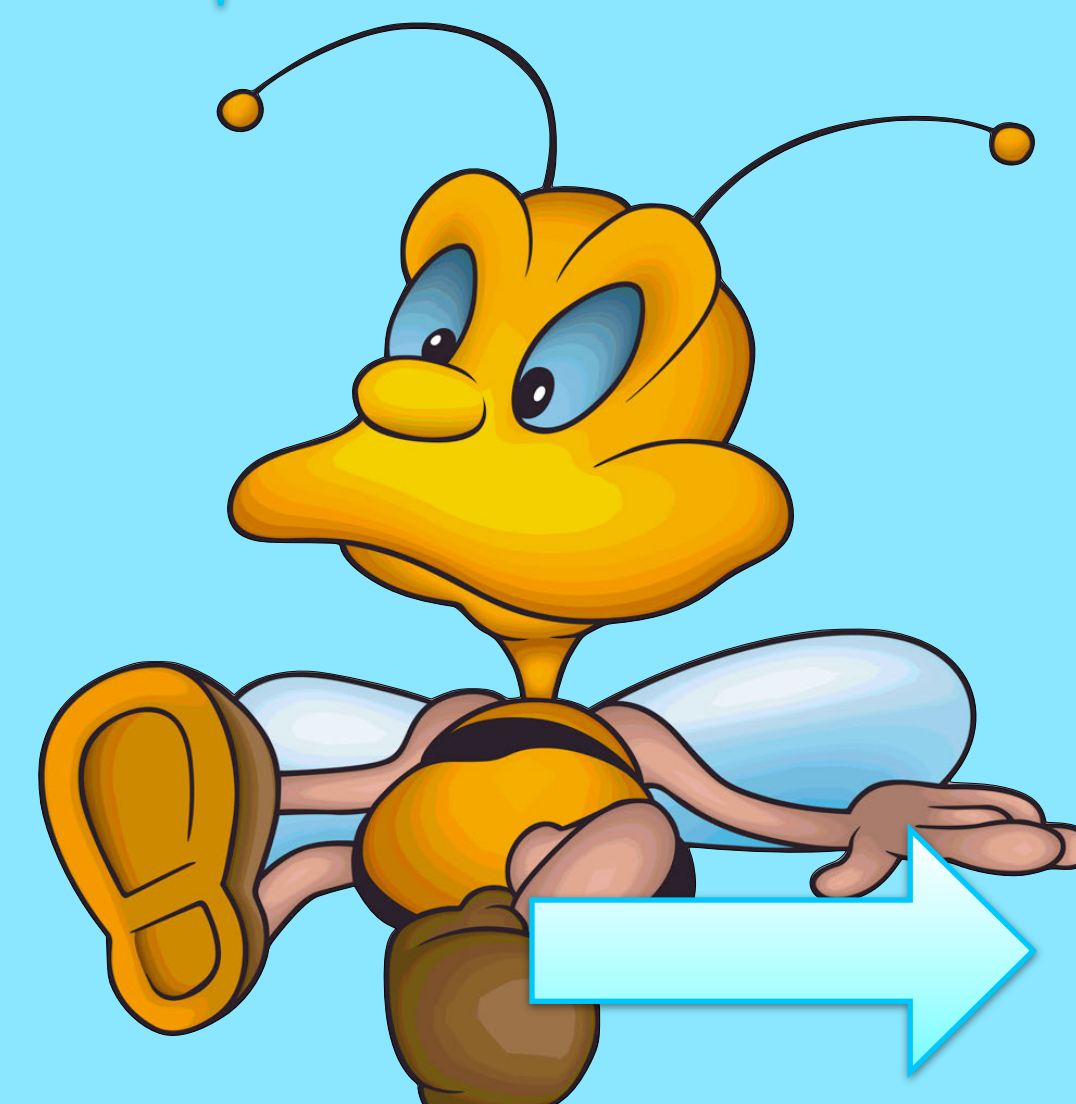

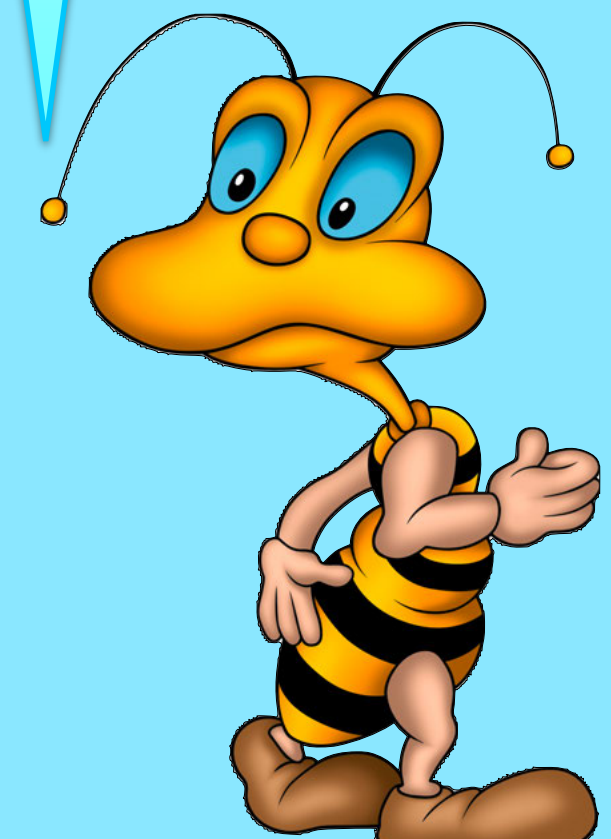
China is the only country in the world where giant pandas live. They are an endangered species. Pandas mostly eat bamboo.
