Listening Comprehension: Questions and Answers

Q1: Why was King Kevin sad?

A1: His pet dragon was sick.

Strategy: Ask the children to listen to the beginning of the audio to hear again the

opening of the story and to raise their hands when something in the story tells them the answer to the question. Draw their attention to 'Why', and point out

that 'Why' asks for a reason.

Q2: What did Carlos have to do to get better?

A2: Run outside (in the day and at night).

Strategy: Ask the children to listen again to the relevant part of the story and to raise their

hands when they hear the answer to the question. Point out that the question begins with 'What', so they will need to talk about a thing or an event in the

answer.

Q3: Why did the king give the vet a bag of coins?

A3: To say thank you./To pay her./Because she made Carlos better.

Strategy: Ask the children to listen again to the end of the story and to raise their hands

when something in the story tells them the answer to the question. Draw their

attention to 'Why', and remind them that 'Why' asks for a reason.
