Calculate:

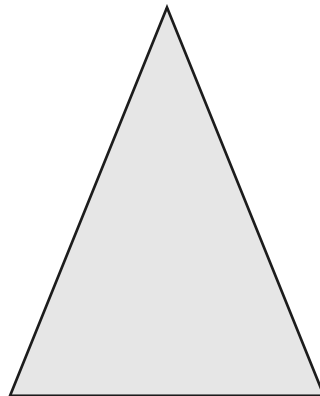
$$0.02 \times 7 = 0.14$$
