Listening Comprehension: Questions and Answers

Q1: In the first poem, the girl sits on a tuffet. What does she sit on in the second

poem?

A1: A bucket.

Strategy: The children will need to listen to the second poem and consider their response.

Q2: List all of the food from all four poems.

A2: Curds and whey, chocolate ice-cream, chapattis and chips, strawberry jelly.

Strategy: The children will need to listen to all of the poems, listening out for food words.

Suggest that they record them in a list, or draw them, to remember.

Q3: Draw a quick picture of the last poem. Put in all of the detail you can remember.

A3: The picture should include a girl on a tuffet/stool, strawberry jelly, a tiger lying

beside her pointing at his belly.

Strategy: The children will need to listen carefully to the final poem, adding the detail to

their drawing.
