Tikal was the largest city and had a population of about 100,000 people.

The Maya still live in Mesoamerica today and they still live in the same way.

The Maya civilisation spanned from 3000BC to 1697AD.

After 900AD, the Maya population started to mysteriously drop.

Temple IV, in Tikal Guatemala, was the tallest Maya pyramid at 70m tall. The Maya used 4 different calendars, including one with 365 days like ours.

The Maya lived in Mesoamerica, which included these countries:
Guatemala, Mexico, Belize, Honduras and El Salvador.
