Otters, deer and birds can be seen by the River Blyth.



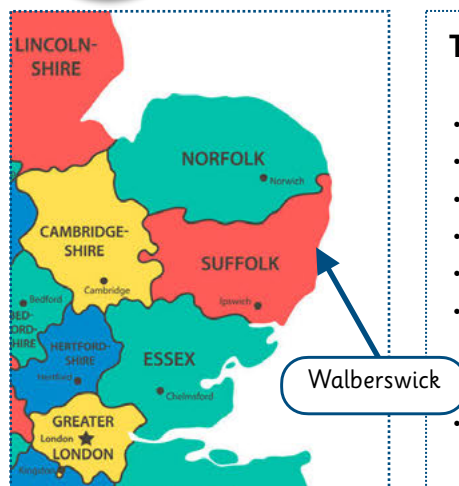

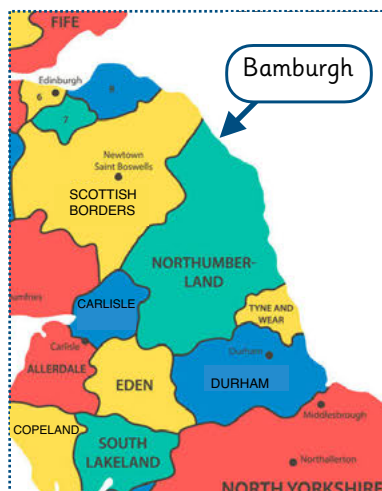

Blackpool has a sandy beach. It is a busy town.



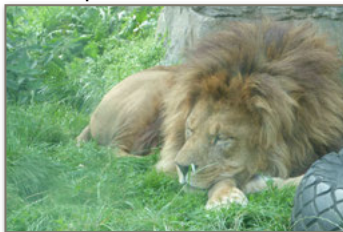
Tourists can pay for donkey rides on the beach.



People pay to go to the top of Blackpool Tower



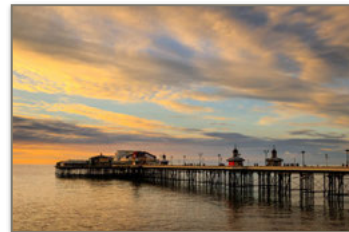
Blackpool Zoo has over 1000 animals, including elephants and lions.

There are three piers in Blackpool. They all have amusements on them.



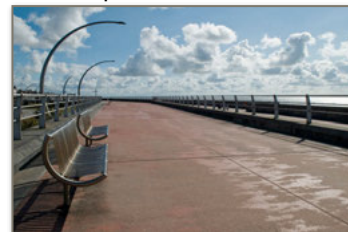

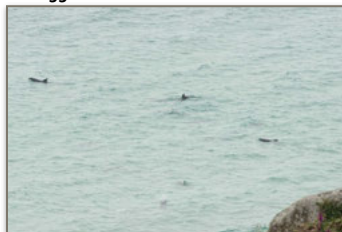
