Justice, honour in battle



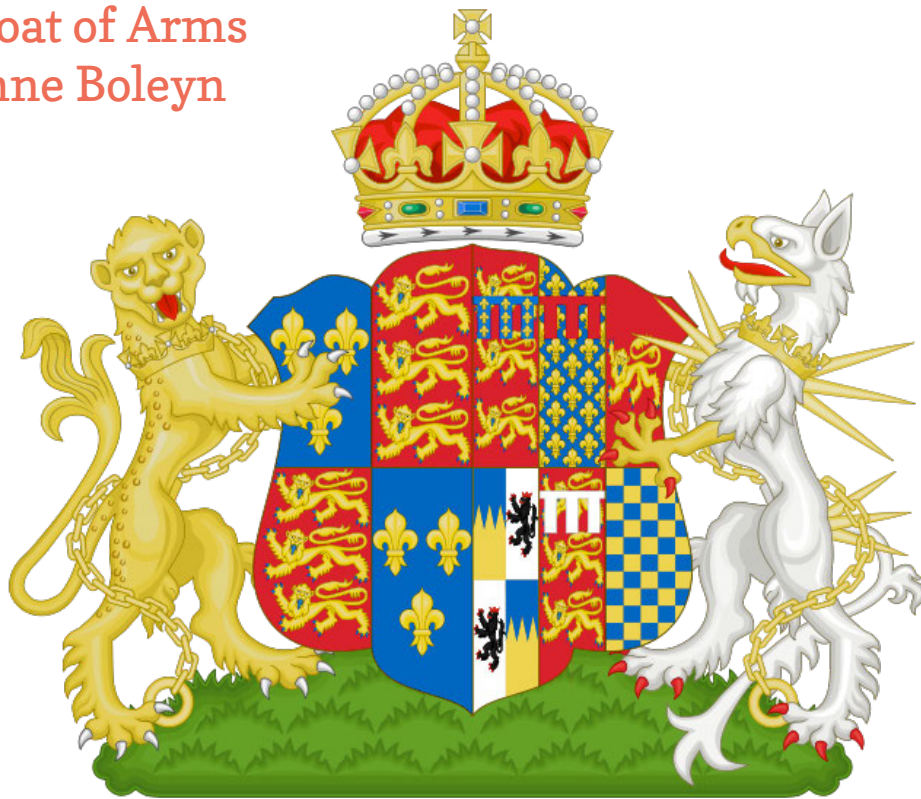
