


Henry VIII became King in 1509.

Henry VIII died in February 1547.



One of these facts was wrong! He was born at Greenwich Palace, he did become King in 1509, but he died in January 1547, not February.





Anyone can create a website and put whatever information they want onto it. This means that facts are not always checked before they are put online for other people to see. If you were researching the Tudors and you wanted to find out if a fact was true or not, how could you do



The best way to check if a fact is accurate or not is to check in several places. If you are doing research online, you could check several different websites. If the fact is the same on each of the websites you check, then the fact is probably correct. You can also check in books. Books are checked by historians and editors before they are printed so are often more accurate than the internet.

When was Catherine of Aragon born?

Catherine of Aragon, (born December 16, 1485, Alcalá de Henares, Spain—died January 7, 1536, Kimbolton, Huntingdon, England), first wife of King Henry VIII of England (reigned 1509–47). The refusal of Pope Clement VII to annul Henry's marriage to Catherine triggered the break between Henry and Rome and led to the English Reformation.

Catherine of Aragon (Spanish: Catalina; 16 December 1485 – 7 January 1536) was Queen of England from June 1509 until May 1533 as the first wife of King Henry VIII; she was previously Princess of Wales as the wife of Henry's elder brother Arthur.

Born in Spain on December 16, 1485, Catherine of Aragon was the daughter of Spanish monarchs King Ferdinand II and Queen Isabella. She married Henry VIII, but did not give birth to a male heir. Catherine refused to annul her marriage so that Henry could marry again, which led to the separation of the Church of England from the Catholic Church. Catherine died in England in 1536. Her only surviving child, Mary Tudor, became queen in 1553.
