Oceans are huge! Can you carefully spread your arms as wide as you can?

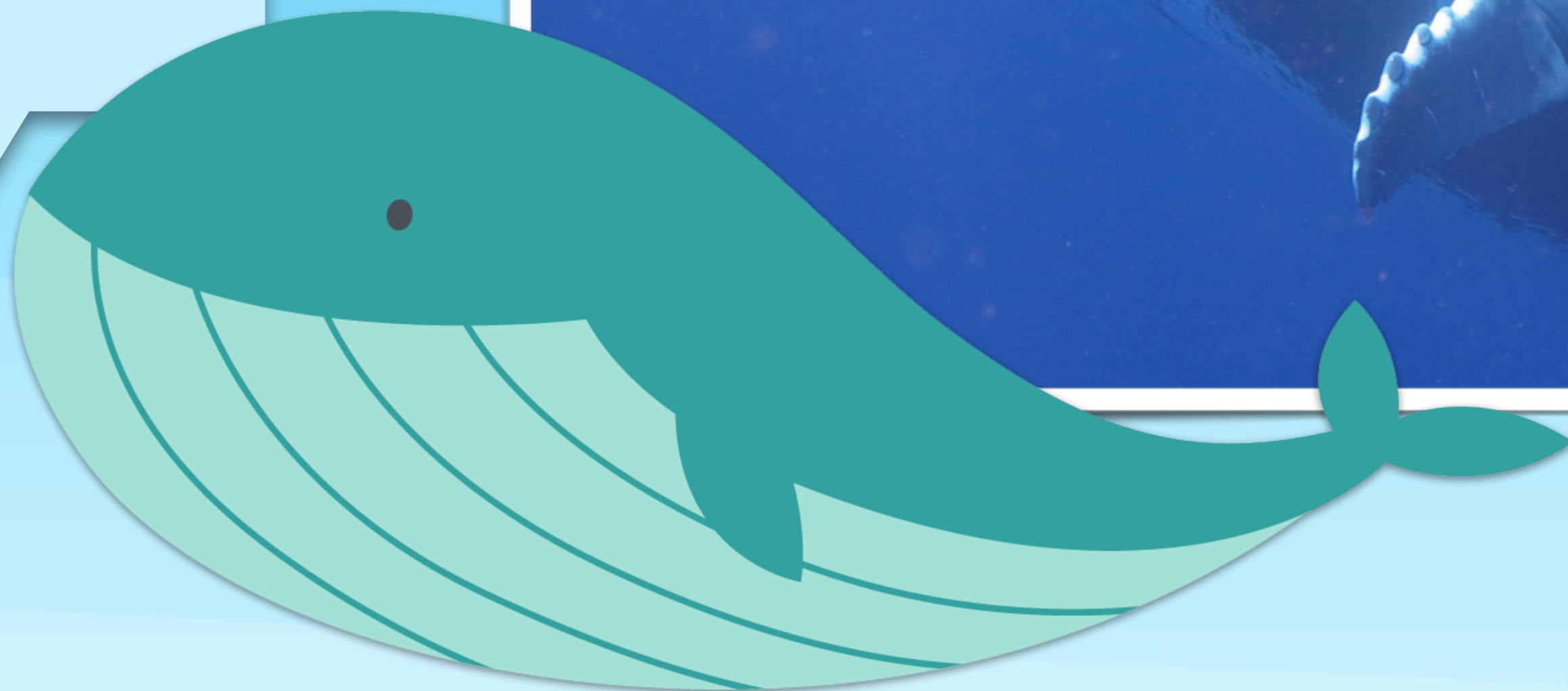

They can be as long as a basketball court!

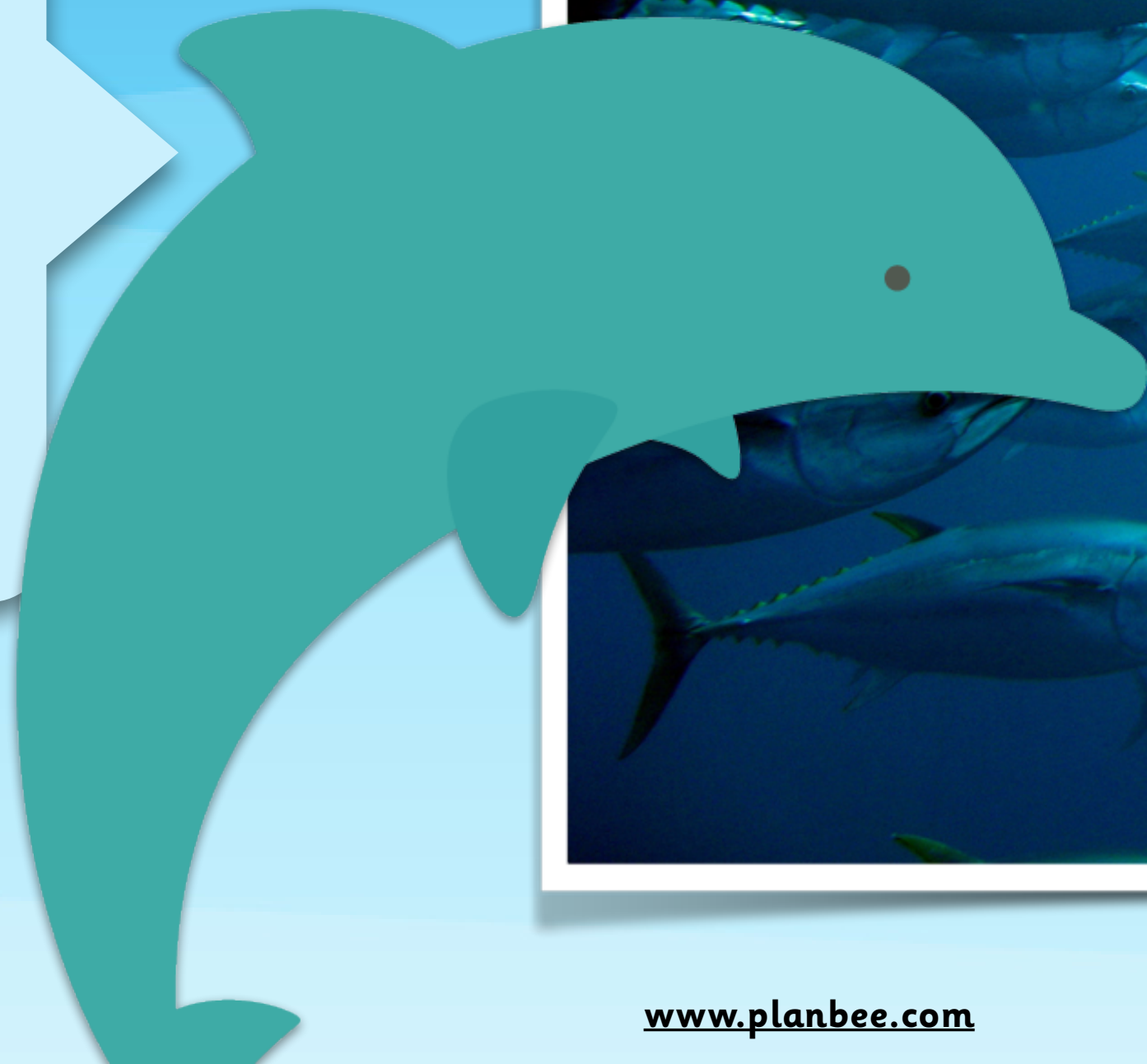
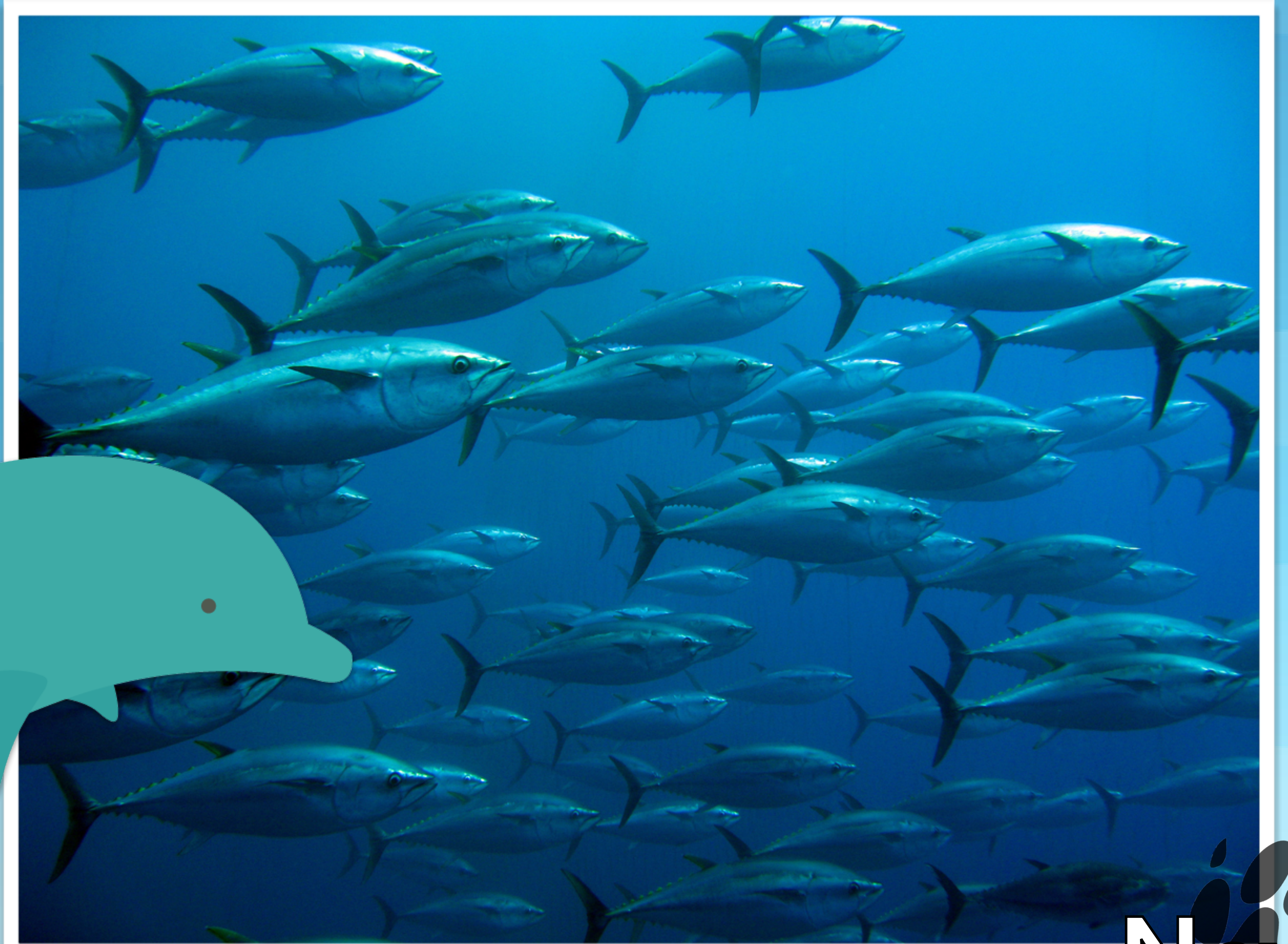

Tuna are a large species of fish. They live in big groups called schools!

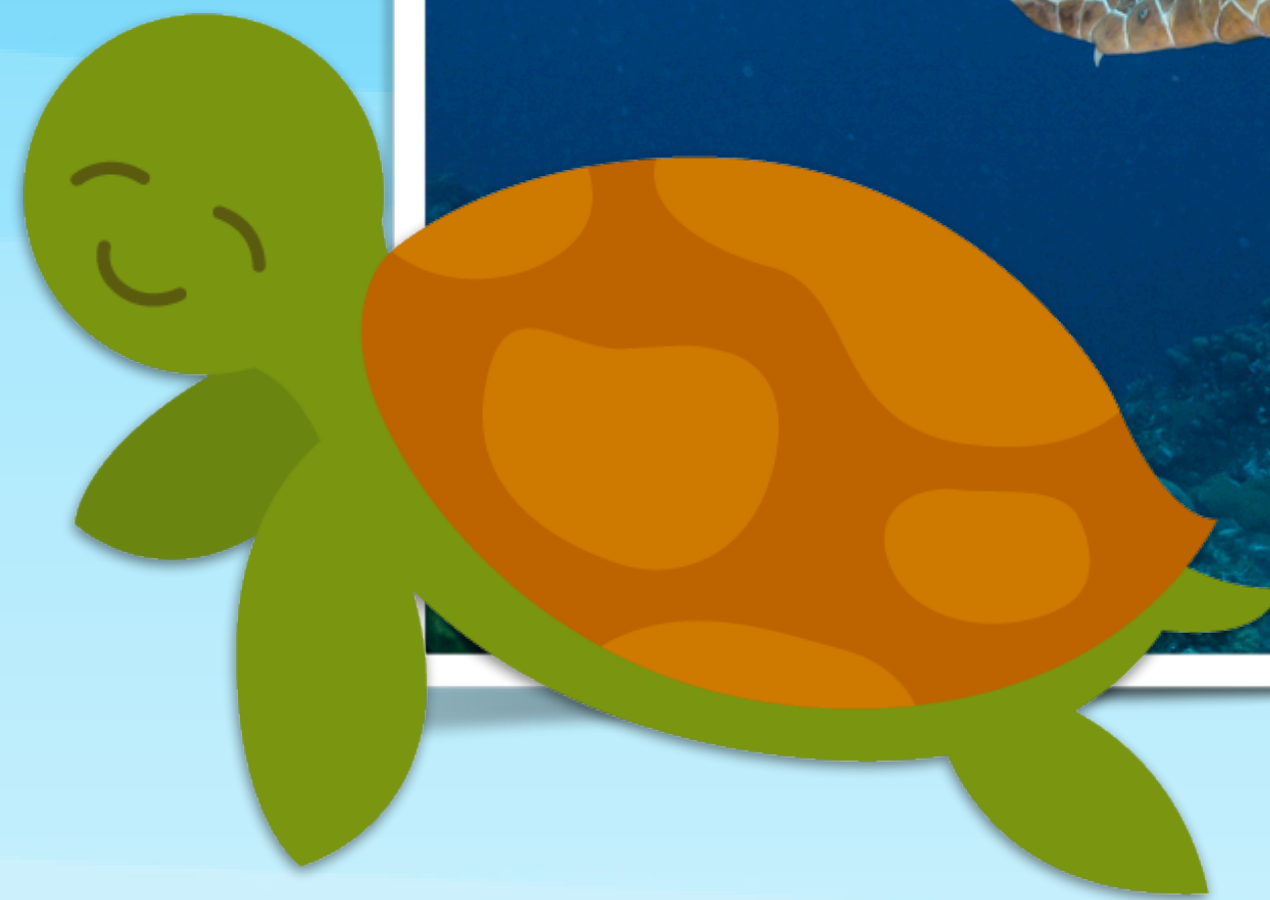

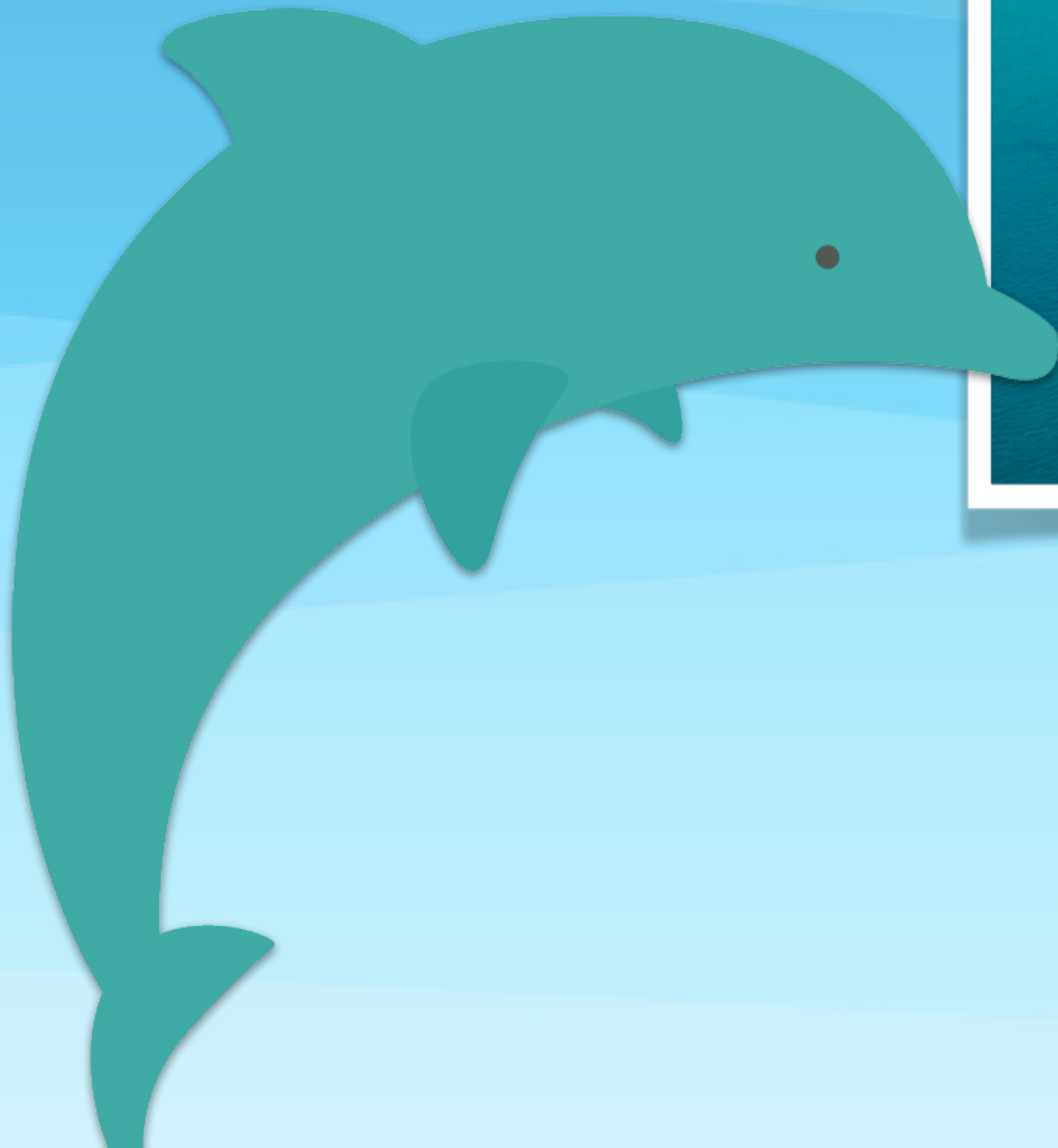

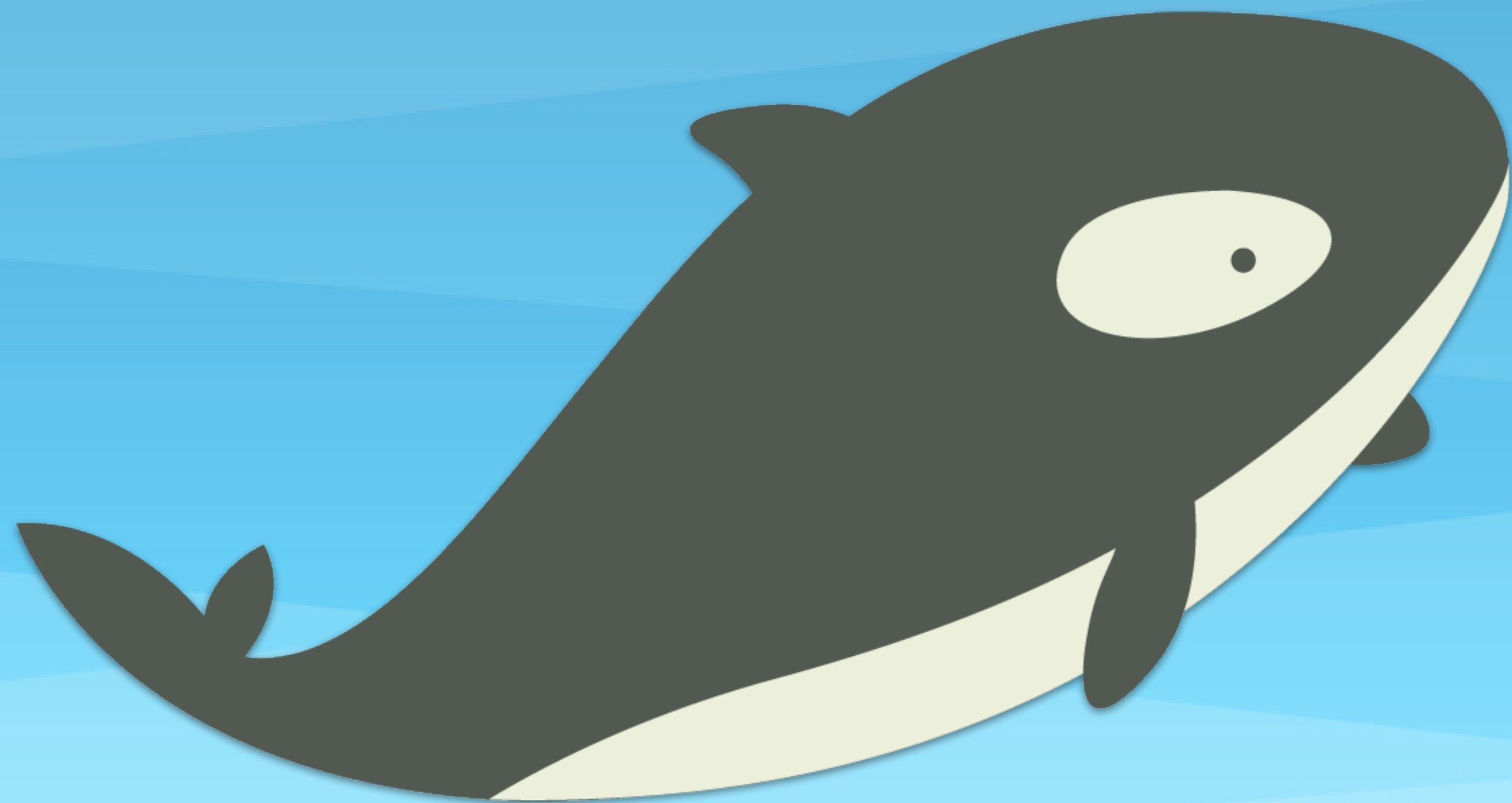
A sea is a smaller area than an ocean. They are usually near some land.



Animals that live in seas prefer to stay in shallower water. Some animals can live in seas and oceans.

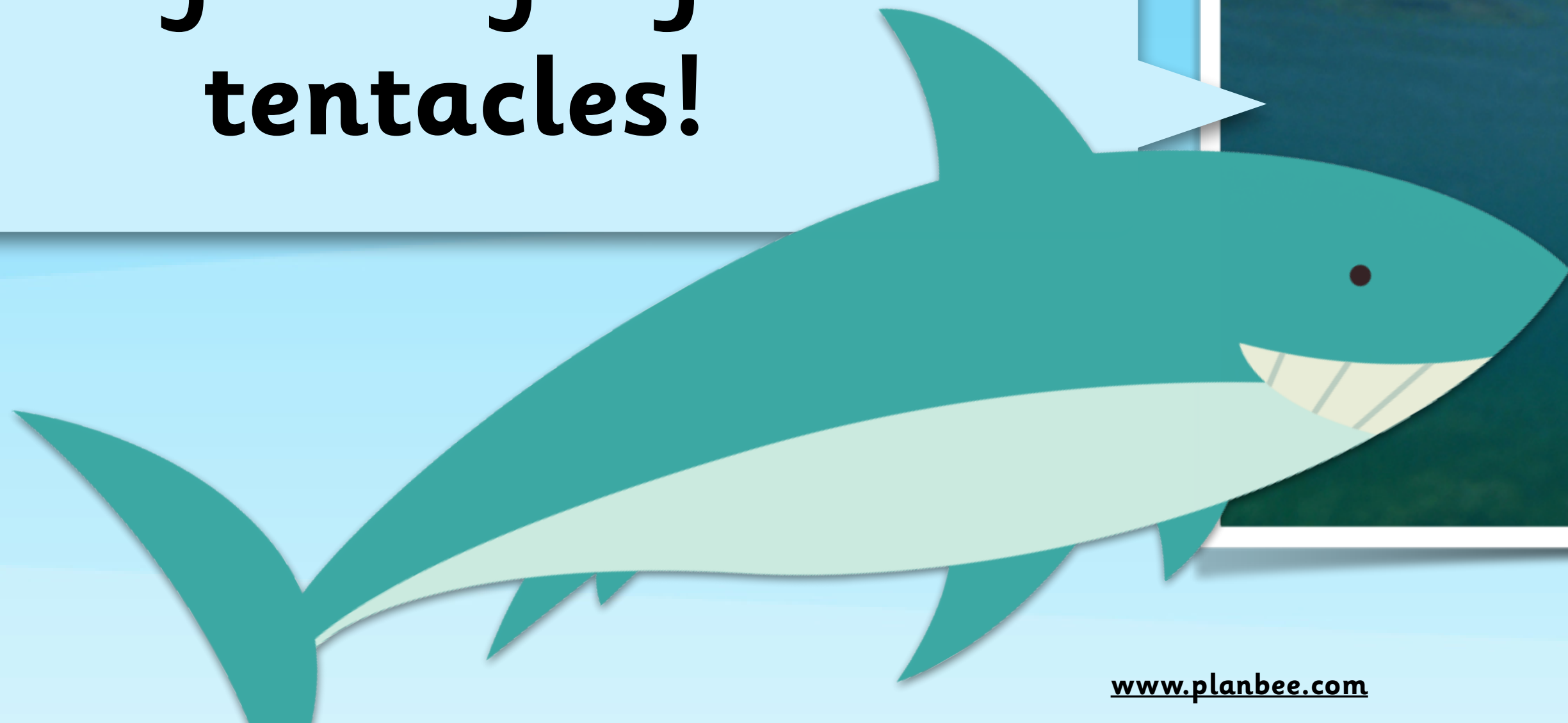
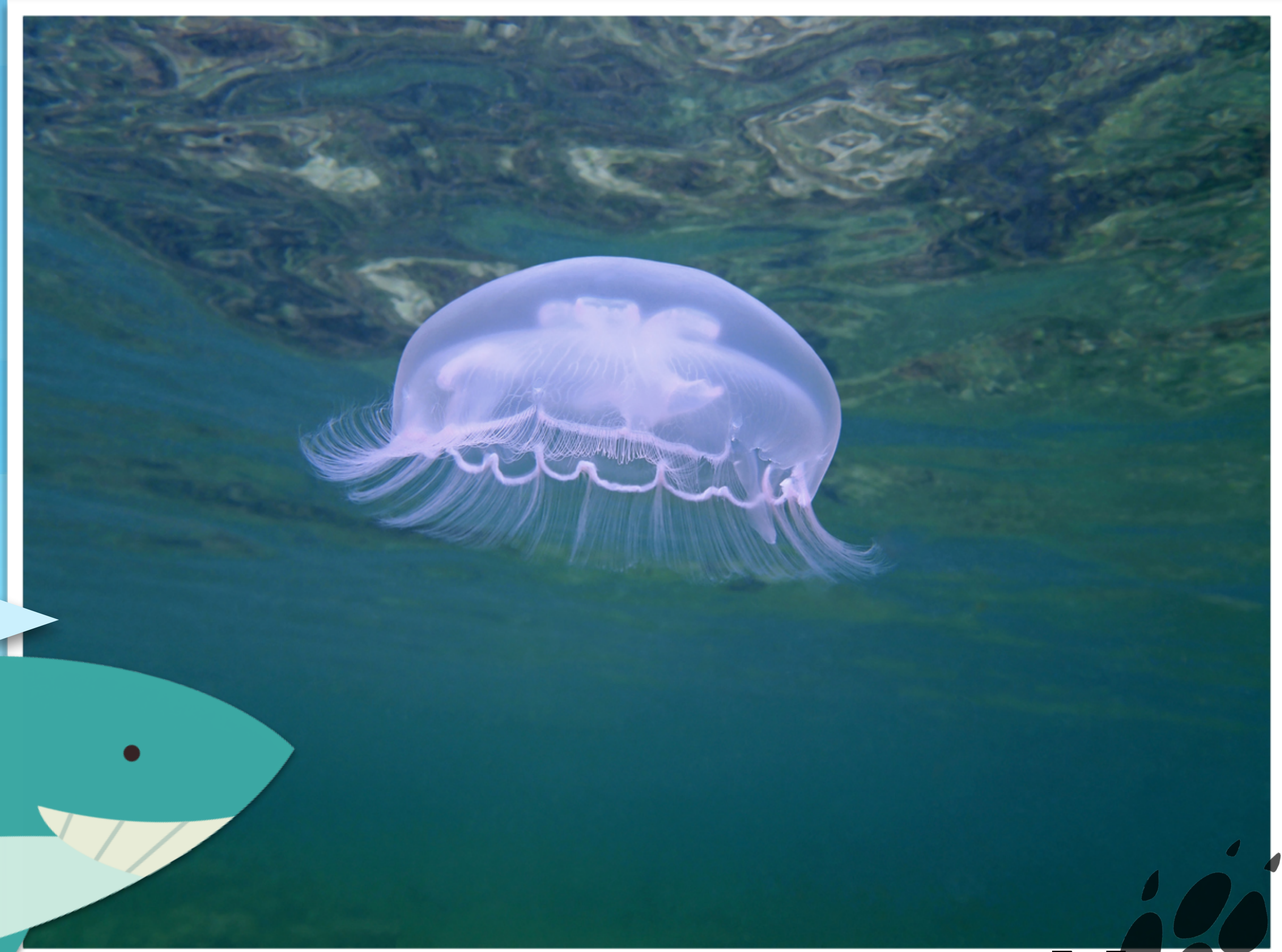
Coral reefs are found in seas. They have an abundance of animals and plants living in them.

**Smaller fish use the rocks and corals for shelter.
Can you spot the octopus and starfish in this photo?**



There are several species of jellyfish which live in the seas around the UK.

Jellyfish can sometimes be washed up onto the beach. It's best to leave them alone to avoid being stung by their tentacles!

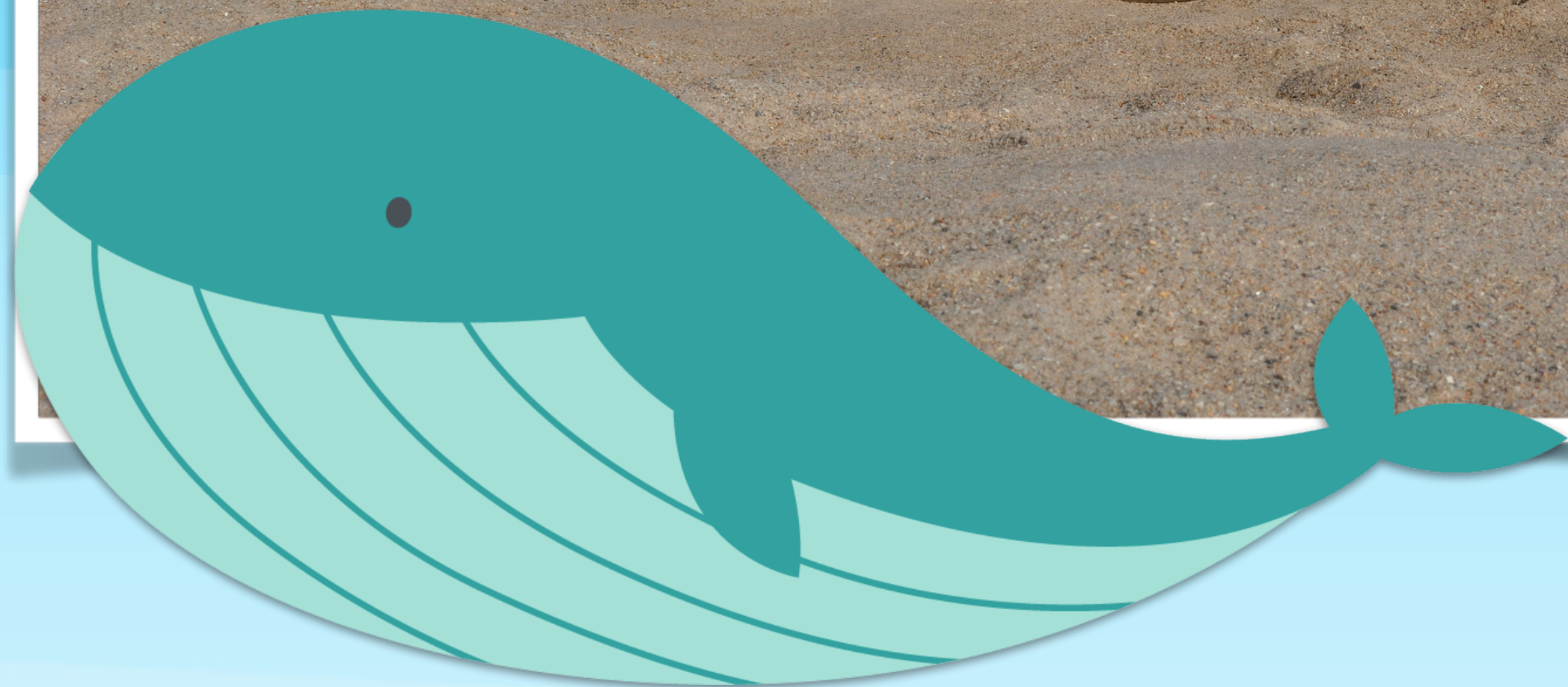

Seals like to live in seas closer to land. They hunt for food in the water and rest on the land.

They live in large groups called colonies. They are very good swimmers but find it harder to move when they're on land.

A rock pool is small pool of water that is left behind when the tide goes out.



A cliff is a high area of rock with a very steep side.

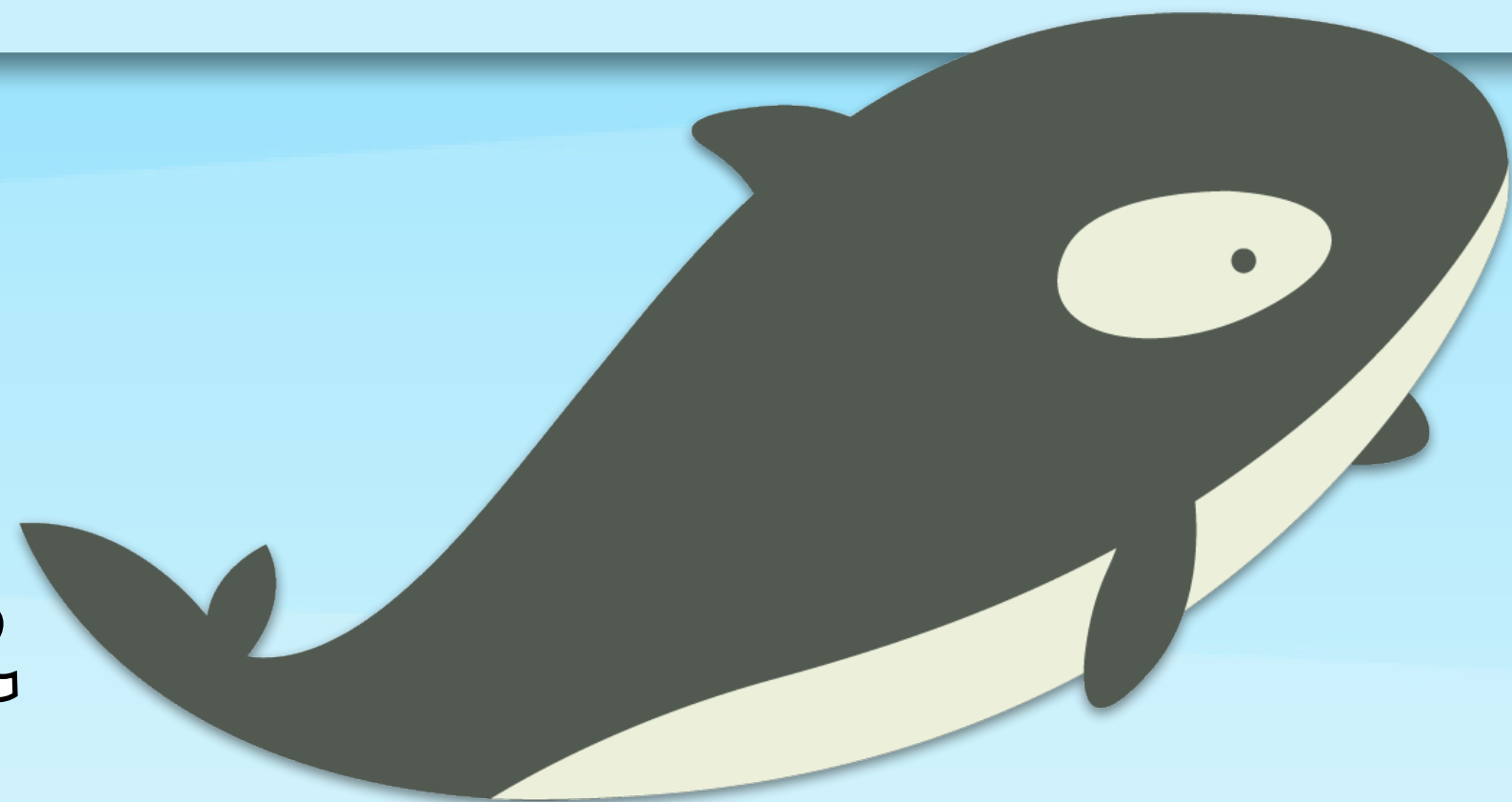


Sea birds often like to make their nests on the cliffs near the water. They hunt for fish and bring them back to their nests.

Puffins avoid predators by living on the steep cliffs.

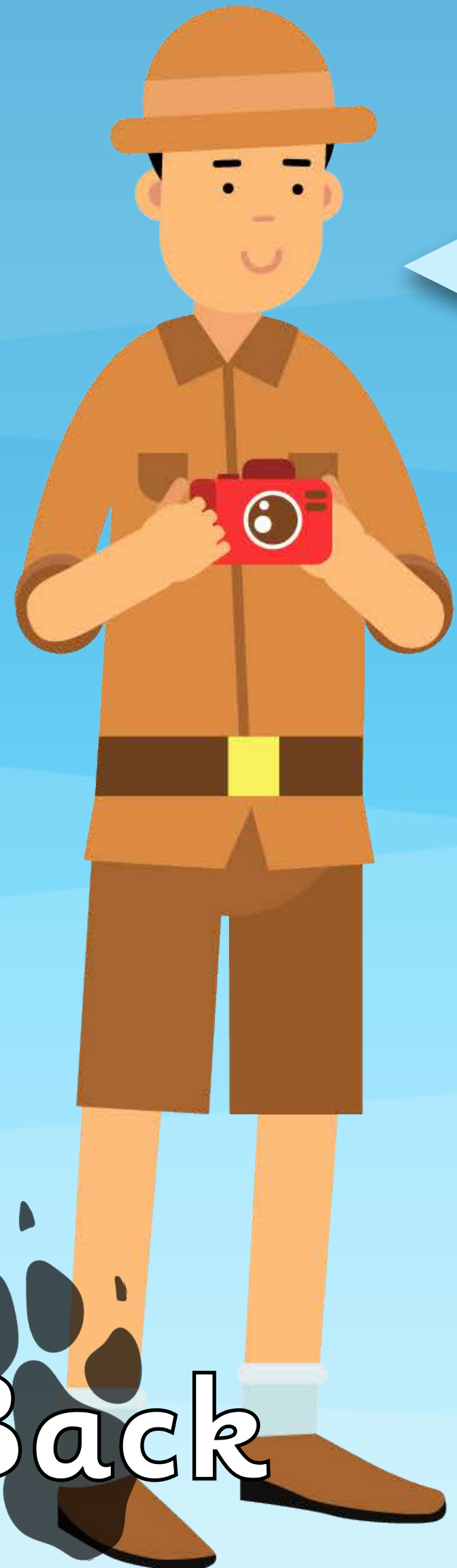

I'd like to see a whale in the wild. They live in wide open areas and can swim in very deep water.



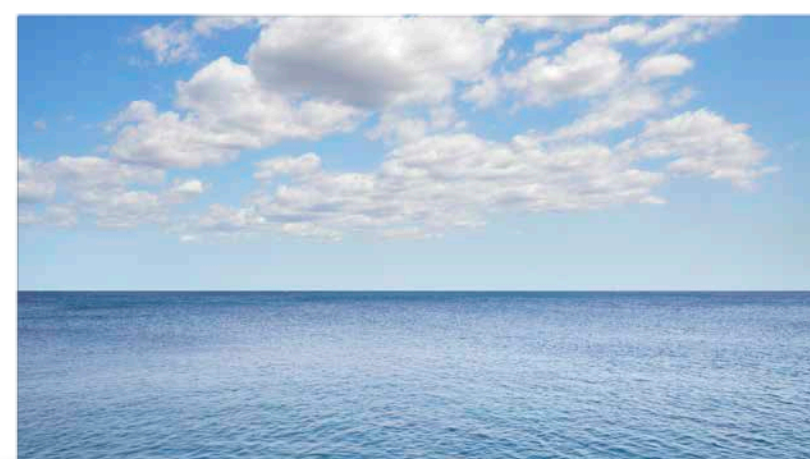

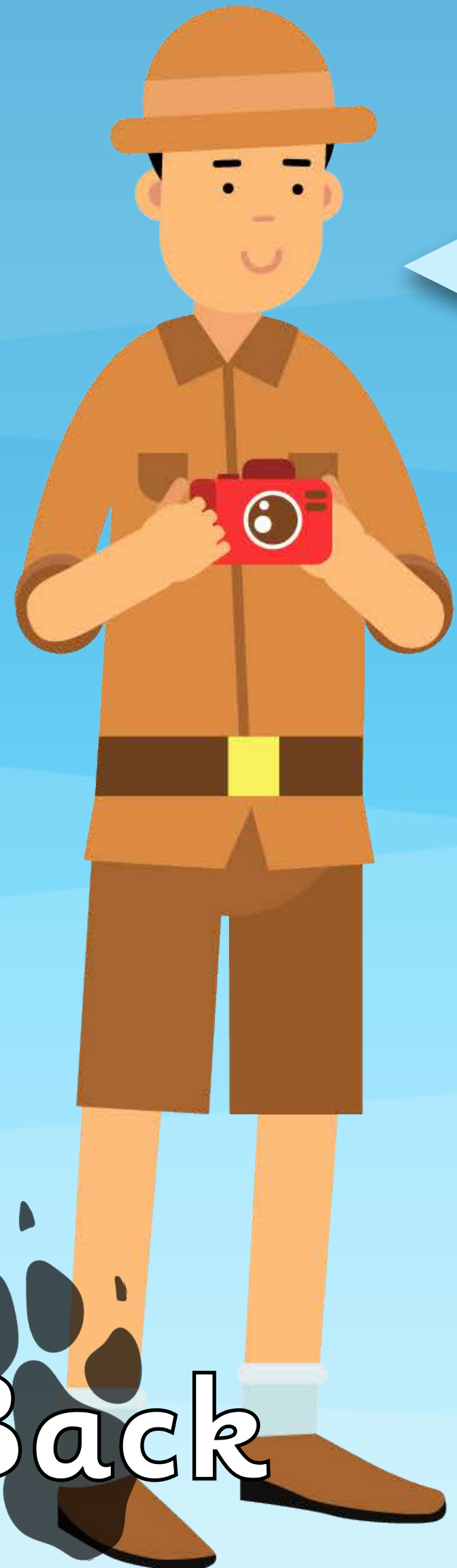

I'm looking for a crab. They live on the land and in sheltered pools. They like hiding among rocks.



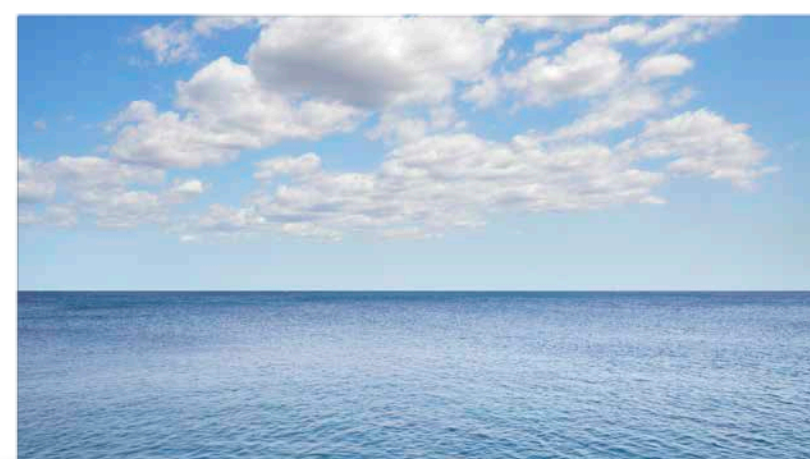

I'm looking for a puffin. They hunt for fish in the water but nest high up so they're safe.



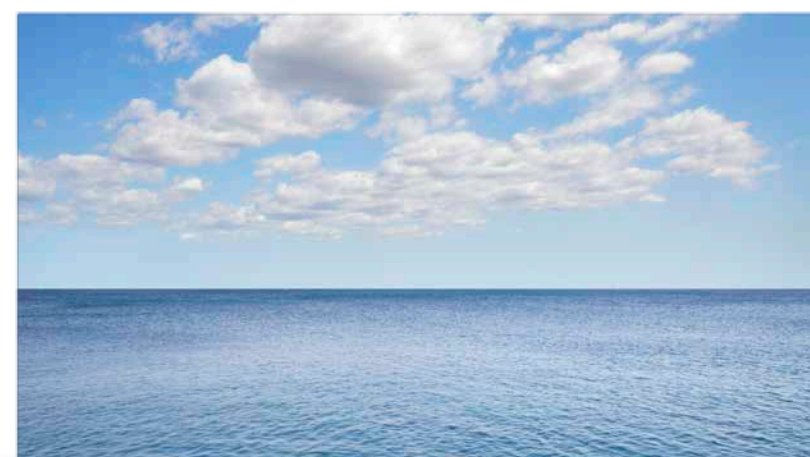

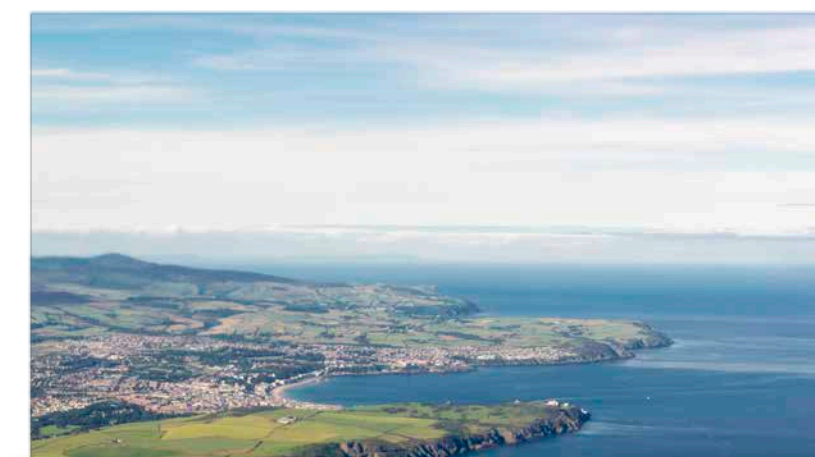
