Animals that live in seas prefer to stay in shallower water. Some animals can live in seas and oceans.










# Coral reefs are found in seas. They have an abundance of animals and plants living in them.

#### Smaller fish use the rocks and corals for shelter. Can you spot the octopus and starfish in this photo?






# There are several species of jellyfish which live in the seas around the UK.

Jellyfish can sometimes be washed up onto the beach. It's best to leave them alone to avoid being stung by their tentacles!










# Seals like to live in seas closer to land. They hunt for food in the water and rest on the land.

They live in large groups called colonies. They are very good swimmers but find it harder to move when they're on land.



# This is a beach. Beaches are found where the sea meets the land. They can be sandy or pebbly.












# On and around the beach you might find cliffs and rock pools.


#### Puffins avoid predators by living on the steep cliffs.




