

**This large space of water is found closer to the land. They are made of saltwater.**

**(sea)**



**These huge spaces of water cover most of the planet. They are made of salt water and can be very deep.**

**(ocean)**



**These pools are left behind after the tide goes out. They are found among rocks and provide a nice sheltered place for small animals.**

**(rock pool)**



**These rocks have a very steep side. They are usually very tall and can be found near the coast.**

	<p><b>Whale</b></p> <p>These animals need wide, deep water to live happily. They are some of the largest animals on Earth.</p>		<p><b>Starfish</b></p> <p>These creatures like to live in sheltered waters.</p>
	<p><b>Seal</b></p> <p>These animals are excellent swimmers but they need to stay near land so that they can rest.</p>		<p><b>Shrimp</b></p> <p>These small creatures like to hide in rock crevices and eat tiny animals (plankton) and algae.</p>
	<p><b>Shark</b></p> <p>These animals live in the water. They eat other animals that live in the water.</p>		<p><b>Crab</b></p> <p>These creatures like to live in sheltered pools and hide among the rocks, but can also survive out of the water.</p>
	<p><b>Turtle</b></p> <p>These animals spend most of their life in the water. Most species of turtle eat sea grass and seaweed.</p>		<p><b>Tuna</b></p> <p>These fish live in huge groups called schools. They like to live in wide open spaces of water.</p>
	<p><b>Puffin</b></p> <p>These sea birds hunt for fish in the water near the coasts. They make their nests in hard to reach places.</p>		<p><b>Octopus</b></p> <p>These creatures live most of their lives in the water but can survive for a short time on land. They hunt for food in shallow waters.</p>



**Jellyfish**

These creatures live in the water. They catch fish and other small animals in their stinging tentacles.
