Start and End of School Day

No child/ren should be on the school site unaccompanied before 8.40 am each school day or after 3.05 pm. The school gates are closed by Mr Essery at 9 am each morning and at 3.20pm at the end of the school day. For Health and Safety reasons, children can only play on the Trim Trail when there is adequate adult supervision in place. This also includes a First Aider being readily available on the school's site. The Trim Trail was originally designed for Key Stage 2 pupils and so some of the equipment is not suitable for some of our younger pupils to play with. Each area of the trail also has a maximum number of pupils able to play on it at any one time. It is with this in mind, that we politely ask that all children do not play on this equipment before or after school, even with parent supervision, to be fair and consistent to all of our families. We also ask that all children dismount from their bikes when entering and exiting the playground and when travelling on scooters to stay by their parent's side. Dogs are also not allowed on the school playground. Thank you for your help and support by following these rules.

Flooding

In the event of flooding on the playground due to excessive rain, children may not be able to enter or exit their classroom via their normal classroom door.

If this is to happen:

- Reception pupils can enter school either via the KS1 door or preferably, through the Nursery door;
- Year 2 pupils can enter via the KS1 door and
- Year 3 to Year 6 pupils can enter via the Hall doors.

We aim to notify parents of these arrangements, on the days when flooding occurs, before 8.30 am or 2.45 pm via School Spider.

Solutions to prevent this from happening are being investigated and hopefully this will be resolved for us shortly.
