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## **Home School Agreement**

<b>School</b>
<b>The school will:</b>
Provide an environment as safe as is possible, which has been cleaned and prepared in accordance with a thorough risk assessment carried out in response to the COVID-19 pandemic;
Continue to follow updated government and local guidance;
Contact parents/carers if your child/ren display any of the recognisably associated symptoms of COVID-19 and ask you to take them home until a test is completed and negative results returned;
Provide remote learning for pupils who are awaiting Covid-19 test results and/or who are well enough to complete school work;
Continue our clear and consistent approach as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations and procedures outlined in this agreement;
Communicate frequently through school texting service, email and the school website alongside phoning in emergencies;
Embed the school's vision and values which captures and celebrates the Christian ethos of the school;
Value every child and support them in making the best progress in their spiritual, moral, social and academic development;
Provide a broad, rich and engaging curriculum;
Work in successful partnership with parents and provide regular opportunities for parents to discuss their child's attainment and progress throughout the school year;
Endeavour for Trinity St Peter's to be a happy and safe place for all pupils.

<b>To best support my child and the school, I/we understand that:</b>
If my child/ren, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school and as a family we will be tested. I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via telephone and a follow up email;
