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Dear Parent/Carer,

Under current Government funding pupils are entitled to receive 15-hours free Nursery Education and Care to commence the term after their third birthday. The 15 hours equates to 5 free Nursery sessions: these can be either a morning or afternoon session or alternatively a full day session.

Many families may also be eligible for the 30 hours free childcare provision which again can be claimed for the term after your child's third birthday. Please do check the following websites for eligibility - <https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/> or the Childcare calculator <https://www.gov.uk/childcare-calculator>. Parents can also choose to access sessions from Clubhouse, the school's 'Wrap Around Care' provision, for Breakfast and After School club as part of the 30-hour provision.

Nursery Sessions

In line with our Admissions Criteria we request that children attend our Nursery for a minimum of **5** sessions, which equates to 15 hours. Please note Admissions Policy and Criteria are subject to change.

Nursery Fees

If you would like your child to access our Nursery provision the half term after they turn 3 years old or access any additional hours above the 15 hours entitlement, the charges for the sessions are detailed below.

Morning / Afternoon session	£15.00
Full Day	£30.00
School Meal (available on request)	£2.31

Clubhouse

Your child can also access (subject to availability):

Breakfast Club (7.40am – 8.50am)	£5.00 per session
After School Club (3.00 pm - 6.00pm)	£10 per session until 5pm, £15 until 6pm – must be pre-booked

A period of notice of a term is required for any request of change/increase hours. This enables us to access any funding required but also enables to ensure that the hours can be accommodated. Any request should be submitted via email using the request for change of sessions form which can be found on our website.
